Derwent Lodge pupils require:



- Blazer (worn every day in and out of school)
- White long sleeve reverse collar blouse (September 2019 onwards)
- Kilt worn with black socks or black tights
- Derwent Lodge Jumper
- Summer dress worn with white socks
- Sports polo top
- Tracksuit top and bottoms
- Skort and running shorts
- Long blue sport socks, short white sport socks with blue hoops
- Swimsuit, swimhat in house colour, goggles
- Derwent Lodge coat
- Derwent Lodge hat and scarf
- School shoes; black and supportive with a strap or laces
- Outdoor and indoor trainers for Hockey, Netball and Cricket
- Trail shoes or football boots or spikes for Cross Country Running.
- Mouthguard and shin pads for Hockey
